KONSTANTINOS GATOS OF GEORGE

Konstantinos Gatos was born in Kokkina Perivleptos, in the municipality of Velestinou, in the prefecture of Magnesia, on 19 November 1940. He graduated from the Medical School of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. He specialised in Psychiatry at the Psychiatric Hospital of Attica and in Neurology and Neuroradiology at the Athens Polyclinic. He specialized in Neurophysiology at the Ludwig Maximilians University of Munich and at the Nursing Foundation of Veterans of



Vietnam in New York. He was a research associate at the Asclepion Volos Clinic of Argyrios Bishakou and Athanasios Kyriakou. Since 1980 he has been director of the Neurological Clinic "Agios Georgios" in Alykes Volos. He specializes in the care of patients with Alzheimer's Disease and related Dementia Syndromes. He has 31 papers published worldwide, of which two are research papers, the first on end-stage patients, which has even been translated into Chinese, and the second on early detection of Alzheimer's disease before visible signs. For his long-standing contribution to the fight against Alzheimer's and the care and treatment of thousands of dementia patients from 1980 to the present day, he was recently awarded by the Municipality of Larissa and the Department of Medicine of the University of Thessaly.
