Assistant professor Martin Rakusa is head of the Medical Research Department and consultant neurologist at the Department of Neurologic Diseases of the University Medical Centre in Maribor, Slovenia; he is also an assistant professor at the Faculty of Medicine, and Faculty of Health Sciences, University of Maribor. Professor Rakusa's clinical work involves treating patients with different types of dementia, and his current main research interest is in the biomarkers for Alzheimer's disease. He has worked on validating common screening tools and developing a new ones for screening for patients with mild cognitive impairment, Alzheimer disease, and mixed dementia. He received several awards and grants, among others the Fulbright grant for research titled "Associations Between Cerebrospinal Fluid Biomarkers and Behavioural Measures in Pre-Symptomatic Alzheimer's Disease" at Mayo Clinic, Rochester, MN, USA Professor Rakusa has published articles in peer-reviewed journals including Alzheimer's & Dementia, Neurology, European Journal of Neurology, Dementia and Geriatric Cognitive Disorders, Brain Topography, and Nature Aging.
