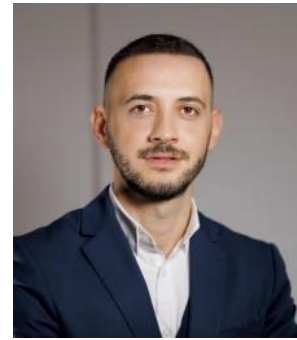


Chadjikyprrianou Andreas
