Electra Chatzidimitriou graduated from the School of Psychology at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH) in Greece, where she also completed her Master's studies in Clinical Neuropsychology. Currently, she is a PhD Candidate at the School of Psychology, AUTH, conducting her doctoral dissertation entitled: "Predictive factors of longitudinal changes in everyday functioning in patients with the behavioral variant of frontotemporal dementia", under the supervision of Dr. Despina Moraitou, Professor of Cognitive Geropsychology. She is a Scientific Associate at the 2nd Neurology Clinic of AHEPA University Hospital and participates in a clinical trial investigating the effectiveness of semaglutide in early-stage Alzheimer's disease. In 2023, she was granted the IKY-Fulbright Scholarship as a PhD Candidate for a 6-month research placement at the Memory and Aging Center of the University of California, San Francisco, in the framework of the collaboration of the State Scholarships Foundation with the Fulbright in Greece. In 2022, she received a doctoral-level scholarship for a 4-week placement at the Department of Old Age Psychiatry at King's College London through the Greek-British Cooperation on Short-Term Scholarships program. She will soon complete her training in Cognitive-Behavioral Psychotherapy through the 4-year European-accredited program of the Greek Association for Behavioral Modification and Research.
